IRS Revises Classification of Vehicles for Clean Vehicle Credit



- Notice 2023-16, 2/3/23
 - Updates Notice 2023-1
 - Will use 40 CFR 600.315-08 to classify SUVs, vans and trucks based on EPA classification
 - Crossovers with status change include Cadillac Lyriq, Ford Mustang Mach-E, and Tesla Model Y
 - Volkswagen ID.4 gets same SUV treatment for 2- and 4-wheel drive versions



Proposed Restaurant Tipping Revenue Procedure Released (SITCA)



- Notice 2023-13, 2/3/23
 - New voluntary tip reporting procedure proposed
 - Service Industry Tip Compliance
 Agreement (SITCA) option for those in
 the service industry (aside from
 gambling)
 - Must have a technology based time and attendance system to report tips
 - Also will be required to meet certain reported tip minimums



Taxpayer Had Complete Mileage Log, But Still Unable to Carry Burden under IRC §274(d)



- Craddock v. Commissioner, T.C. Summ. Op. 2023-4, 1/30/23
 - Taxpayer had mileage log that accounted for every mile - but there were issues
 - Two entries on the log had him in different states on the same day
 - Multiple bank statement entries showed purchase of fuel in a state log says he wasn't in
 - Also didn't really separate out commuting to regular job or for errands
