ERC Voluntary Compliance Program Ends, IRS Discusses the Future



- "IRS Employee Retention Credit compliance effort tops \$1 billion threshold since fall; Voluntary Disclosure Program suspended after March 22, special withdrawal program remains open as audits, investigations intensify," News Release IR-2024-78, March 22, 2024
 - IRS indicates they will intensify the review of ERC claims, including audits, promoter investigations and criminal investigations (25 cases have had charges filed, 12 convictions and average sentence of 24 months)
 - Processing moratorium continues into "late spring" for claims filed after moratorium was announced

Senate Finance Committee Chair Indicates There May Be a Vote on Cloture for HR 7024



• Doug Sword, "Cloture Vote on Tax Package Looking More Likely," Tax Notes Today Federal, March 22, 2024

- SFC Chair Wyden said to believe there are 60 votes ٠ in the Senate to enact HR 7024
- Ranking member Sen. Crapo declined to predict the outcome of such a vote
- Could be an interesting vote for a number of ٠ reasons, including business pressure to get the R&D issue, §163(j) and bonus depreciation issues resolved

IRS Asks Supreme Court to Overturn Third Circuit's Culp Decision



- Petition for Writ of Certiorari, *Commissioner v. Culp*, March 18, 2024
 - Is §6213(a)'s 90 day deadline to file in Tax Court for redetermination of a tax deficiency a hard and fast deadline?
 - CA3 in *Culp* answered no, looking to SCOTUS ruling in *Boechler, P.C. v. Commissioner*, 596 U.S. 199 (2022) which involved CDP redetermination filing (30 day deadline)
 - The Tax Court, in a later opinion, held that Boechler wasn't applicable to \$6213(a) (Sanders v. Commissioner, 161 T.C. No. 8 (2023))
